CENTENNIAL VILLA ASSISTED LIVING VISITATION GUIDELINES

We are pleased to loosen our visitation restrictions to allow visits in the apartments and to allow limited weekend/evening visits! Visitors will be required to adhere to infection prevention and control safety practices in order to enter the building for indoor visitation. **Unscheduled visits will not be allowed into the building. You MUST call for an appointment.** These visitation guidelines are for Independent Living and Assisted Living only and subject to change as necessary.

Please review the following:

- **Entry Screening:** Staff will actively screen all visitors entering the facility for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, including a temperature reading, at a screening station prior to the visitor walking through the facility. Visitors should come to the main entrance of the 600 or 660 building to be screened.
- **Visitor Sign-in and Out: All visitors are asked to sign in upon arrival to the facility.** Visitors are asked to leave contact information when they sign in.
- **Hand Hygiene:** Visitors will perform hand hygiene before walking through the building. Alcohol-based hand rub is available for persons visiting residents and signage is present throughout the facility for hand hygiene.
- **Facemask Required:** Visitors must wear a mask or other face covering as determined by the organization, at all times.
- **Limited Visitor Movement in Building:** The visitor must take a straight path to the apartment. Visitors will be asked to minimize restroom use in the facility.
- **Visitation Schedule:** **Visitors must call, in advance, to schedule visitation times.**

- **Number of Visitors are Limited Per Resident:** 2 visitors are allowed.
- **Number of Visits per Week:** In order for all to have visitors, we may limit the number of visits per tenant to one per week.
- **Number of Visitors in the building at one time:** Each apartment building will be allowed up to 2 visits at a time; 2 in the 600 building, 2 in the 660 building. Weekend and evening visit times may be restricted due to staff availability.
- **Length of Visit:** In order to allow for more visits, we limit visits to one hour.
- **Physical Contact is Not Permitted:** Due to the risk of exposure, holding hands, kissing and other forms of physical contact is not allowed during visits.
 - **Restrictions for Children & Pets:**
 - a) No Visitors under age 12.
 - b) Pets are not allowed during visiting.
- **Social Distancing:** All visitors must maintain 6 feet social distance.
- **Taking Residents Outdoors:** Residents may accompany their visitors outside for a walk, maintaining 6 feet of social distance. Pushing a wheelchair is an acceptable activity while wearing a mask.

It will be nice to see new faces in our buildings again. Please let us know if you have any concerns or questions.
