CENTENNIAL VILLA ASSISTED LIVING VISITATION GUIDELINES

Fob access has been restored for family members who have an issued fob. No appointments are necessary.

Visitors are required to adhere to infection prevention and control safety practices in order to enter the building for indoor visitation. These visitation guidelines are for Independent Living and assisted Living only and subject to change as necessary.

Please review the following:

- **Entry Screening: Visitors will self-screen** upon entering the facility for signs and symptoms of COVID19, including a temperature reading, at a screening station prior to the visitor walking through the facility.
- **Hand Hygiene:** Visitors will perform hand hygiene before walking through the building. Alcohol-based hand rub is available for persons visiting residents and signage is present throughout the facility for hand hygiene.
- **Facemask Required:** Visitors must **wear a mask.**
- **Limited Visitor Movement in Building:** The visitor must take a straight path to the apartment. Visitors will be asked to minimize restroom use in the facility.
- **Number of visitors allowed per resident:** 2 visitors are allowed at a time.
- **Social Distancing:** Visitors are asked to remain 6 feet social distance from staff and other residents.
- **Taking Residents Outdoors:** Residents may accompany their visitors outside. Outdoors is the best place to visit.
- **Physical Contact:** Fully vaccinated residents may choose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor while wearing a well-fitting face mask (if tolerated) and by performing hand hygiene before and after.
